## WINTER DRINK TRADITIONS...

**Try our German Glühwein**—*Glühwein* can be most closely likened to mulled wine. The German word itself directly translates to mean ‘glow wine’ in English. This name was derived from the red hot irons used to heat the wine across the Germanic cultures when the drink first became popular hundreds of years ago. Wine was first recorded as spiced and heated up in the First Century in Rome. From there the mulled wine developed over Europe. The Romans traveled around, conquering much of Europe trading and spreading the popular drink. Christmas markets in Europe are often called **Christkindlmarkt**, translated Christmas baby market, and is a popular place to enjoy a mug of Glühwein.

**Tom & Jerry Anyone?** The Tom and Jerry cocktail is a traditional Christmas drink very popular in the Midwest but virtually unknown in other parts of the country. Similar to eggnog, this “batter” as it is called, is then mixed with hot water (or sometimes hot milk), rum or brandy, and sprinkled with nutmeg. The invention of the Tom and Jerry cocktail is generally credited to British journalist Pierce Egan in the 1820’s. Mr. Egan wrote a book, and subsequent play, called *Life in London*, in which the main characters are named Tom and Jerry. It is believed that he introduced the cocktail as a way to promote his book and play. The cocktail reached its height of popularity in the early to mid 1900’s and special punch bowl sets were even made specifically for serving the cocktail, with the words Tom and Jerry on the bowl. The drink has gained popularity again in recent years, but never really fell out of favor in the Mid-West, where you can find pre-made batter to make the drink easily at home.
